Basic Safety

- Ear and eye protection must be worn at all times when shooting.
- Do NOT rest the barrel of the gun on your toe.
- Do NOT point your gun in an unsafe direction.
- Do NOT engage in horse play on the range.
- Always store your gun UNLOADED in a rack or designated area.
- Actions are to remain OPEN at all times.
- Do NOT load your gun until the shooter before you has shot. The bullet cannot touch any part of your gun until the previous shooter is done.
- You must have completed hunter safety to participate in this 4-H program.
- If you need help or your gun jams, stop and get the instructors attention immediately.

Equipment Needed for Shotgun

- **A shotgun suitable for the participant and the project they are participating in. (The leaders can help with this).**
- **Earplugs**
- **Shooting pouch or vest**
- **Safety glasses**
- **Shells (If you came to every practice shoot you will use at least 3 cases of shells just for trap). It is cheaper to buy the shells by the case.**
- **And finally, a good attitude!**

*****Shotgun is NOT the cheapest 4-H project so please keep that in mind.**
